# What Holy Communion Means to Me

Traditionally in our church, here at Floreat, we celebrate the Sacrament of Holy Communion on the first Sunday of each month.

Recently the format has changed, and instead of being served as we remain seated, we now walk to the front of the church to receive the elements from the four designated Elders. (Those who prefer to remain seated and are served in theirs seats.)

The same format was used in Wesley Church on the day of Reuben's Ordination. We all walked forward in line, and when I reached the front, the Minister who was serving the bread, was unfamiliar to me...but he glanced at my name-badge, and then looked back to me and said... "Maxine, this is the body of Christ, broken for you."

I had not expected such an intimate and personal invitation. But there it was...and suddenly, in that special moment...I felt as though a 'bubble of grace' surrounded us both...'the giver...and the receiver'.

Such a spiritual connection surprised me and created an unforgettable, watershed moment for me.

So now, on Communion Sunday, I have a new awareness of how the act of 'going forward' creates an opportunity for us to actively prepare ourselves to be ready for that intimate moment of 'giving and receiving' ...when we invite the Holy Spirit into our lives and we receive the blessing of His abundant and unconditional gift of Grace and Peace.
