Lent



The season of Lent in the liturgical year commemorates the 40 days Jesus Christ spent fasting in the desert and enduring temptation by Satan, as recorded in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke, before beginning his public ministry. The 40 days begin on Ash Wednesday and finish on Holy Saturday before we

celebrate the resurrection of Christ on Easter Sunday. For those keeping count, we do not count Sundays during the Lent season as part of the 40 days as every Sunday is a celebration of Christ and the resurrection. If you are committing to a Lenten discipline this season you get a break each Sunday!

Most traditional denominations mark the season, including orthodox, eastern, catholic, Anglican, and the Uniting Church. Some Baptist, Pentecostal, Reformed, and Methodist churches will mark Lent while others will not.

While some do not like the season of Lent because it can be a darker and less joyous season, I believe it is important to mark. We use the revised common lectionary for our Bible readings each week partly because it challenges the preacher and the congregation to read and interpret a wide selection of the Bible, often some difficult parts. Similarly, I believe the liturgical calendar for the church year offers us times of celebration and times of confession and reflection. And so, I encourage you to embrace the discomfort and difficulty that Lent can bring as part of constantly reflecting and renewing our faith.

Ash Wednesday Service



I had never attended an Ash Wednesday service before.

When I raced into church on Wednesday morning fresh from the pool where I had just completed my daily swim, my

mind was crowded with all the busy-ness planned for the coming day. As I sought to banish those busy thoughts from my consciousness, the service began with the sounding of the bells and proceeded through a liturgy that left many of us moved and thoughtful.

The reading from Matthew 6:1-21 was thought provoking and I found myself mulling over whether or not I had ever given anything, financial, time, energy or otherwise and not received any reward for it. I struggled to remember any time when a gift given had not returned to me some kind of reward, even that warm inward smile of knowing one had made someone's day a little brighter. It brought with it a realisation that we must persevere with those gifts we give with only a negative return or none at all, not even satisfaction. The scriptures exhort us to do so in order to secure God's reward. That feels a bit like a bribe to me so maybe I just need to accept that a gift given without any positive return is still a gift worth giving.

The receiving of the mark of the cross was a very special part of the service and by the time all wore the mark of Christ, there were quite a few glistening eyes amongst us. This was a special service, one that left more of a mark on me than merely the cross in ash. I'll be ready and waiting for next year's Ash Wednesday service.
