## Gathering, Word, Community, Sending

Over the last two months we have sought to highlight the group/ committee that we, as a congregation, are going to be praying for.

To raise their profile, we have begun having highlights after the announcements and including a symbol during the offering and including them in our prayers of intercession.

At the last worship committee meeting we discussed how this was going and its impact on worship. While we have really appreciated hearing about the weekly prayers, the service can feel a bit slow to get going. So, we are making a few small adjustments.

The weekly prayer highlight will no longer be at the beginning of the service. After a few announcements we want the beginning of the service to focus on the gathering of worship and we want to get started sooner rather than later. This also has the added benefit of removing a very contextual element from the beginning of our worship which some congregations stream.

After the gathering we have our Word section of the service where we introduce the theme, hear from scripture, and hear the sermon. Then we have what we are calling the community section. The time when we give and pray for the wider community. We will now include the weekly prayer highlights here, so that it is closer to the offering and prayers. The service then finishes with the final hymn and the sending off.

These are small tweaks to our order of service but ones that we hope will lead to a better flowing and more life-giving service. Let us know what you think of the adjustments.

## REPORT ON CREATIVE LIVING CENTRE ANNUAL PUBLIC MEETING SUNDAY 10 MARCH

Members attended the CLC APM Sunday 10th March. Eight CLC Board members were present [Two live remotely in Melbourne and Derby and couldn't be present. Two other Board members sent apologies]. Supporter attendance was affected by a clash of times with Wembley Downs UC Annual General Meeting resulting in apologies from interested friends from that church. Representatives from Trinity North were present.

Chair of CLC Geoff Schupp gave a brief overview of 2023 Board changes in membership, Marie Yuncken and Lee-Anne Burnett gave a detailed report on the work of Boab and Black Pearl Network. The work in the Mowanjum Community and in Indonesian Papua is exciting and always facing change and new challenges.

Kalli Christou, the recently appointed Treasurer of CLC gave a review of 2023 finances and these figures indicate a few financial headwinds, particularly associated with the cost of the June 2023 teachers Professional Development which did not bring the expected provision of airfares, Papua to Perth and return, for which Black Pearl had expected Papuan Presbytery [Klasis] support. Arrangements have been put in place to recover this cost from salary provisions provided by BPN, but the impact on the BPN 2023 budget was around \$19,000. The reduction in corporate sponsorship also had an effect.

The 2024 Budget was presented which shows a balanced budget brought about by some tough decisions [reducing the number of teaching places] and the handover of the Clean Water Program to three Papuan universities bringing with it a diminishing financial involvement of BPN. The fledgling Vocational Training - Hospitality and Tourism in Sorong has been suspended as finding trained staff with English and Hospitality & Tourism

expertise is very difficult - no suitable applicants presented following a recent recruitment drive, so with the need to conserve funds generally and no suitable staff available, the Board decided to put this project on hold.

A LotteryWest Grant has been won by Boab Network for a Kimberley Aboriginal Community on the Broome - Derby Highway -Pandanus Park - near Willare Bridge which will fund the refurbishment of the Community Hall [known as the 'Refreshment Rooms'] which will be a community hub. WiFi connection will also be installed - this community doesn't even have this 'normal' connection to the world. Families at Pandanus Park are related to families at Mowanjum, and their call for help was through this connection.

Boab and Black Pearl Network represents the WA Uniting Church, [particularly the Floreat, Trinity North, Wembley Downs, Wesley/Trinity UCIC among other suburban churches] in the work in these distant communities. This work is a special and immediate calling.
