# Sarah Pearce's fundraiser for Chain of Hope

At the Palm Sunday service I outlined how my daughter Sarah is undertaking the Banjul Half Marathon on 28 April as a fundraiser for the charity Chain of



Hope, which aims to provide heart surgery for children from countries where none is available (such as The Gambia, where Sarah is working) by taking them to a country in which it is available.

Sponsorship of one child requires GBP5,000 (just over AUD10,000), and this is Sarah's fundraising target. (If she raises more, the excess will go toward another child.)
