Season of Creation



September 1 was proclaimed as a Day of Prayer for Creation for the Eastern Orthodox Church by Ecumenical Patriarch Dimitrios I in 1989. It was embraced by other major Christian European churches in 2001, and by Pope Francis for the Roman Catholic Church in 2015. In recent years, many Christian

churches have begun celebrating the "Season of Creation" (also known as Creation Time) between September 1 and October 4, the Feast of Saint Francis that is observed by some Western traditions. Saint Francis is the author of the Canticle of the Creatures, and the Catholic patron saint of those who promote ecology.

Now around the world, 2.2 billion Christians are invited to pray and care for Creation during this season. Many Uniting Churches will take up this call and theme some or all of their services in September around our environment. In recent years the call to care for creation has become more poignant as climate change continues to impact everyone but frequently it impacts vulnerable populations the hardest.

Here at All Saints Floreat, we are marking the Season of Creation through the 5 Sundays in September this year. Each Sunday will focus on a different aspect of nature.




