# Summary of the Church Council Meetings held on Tuesday 22 October and 26 November 2024

- An operating Bank Account with The Uniting Investment Fund has been opened.
- Electronic equipment for the receiving of donations and giving from The Uniting Investment Fund will be made available during 2025.
- ◆ The Disability Inclusion Plan no meetings have taken place since the last Church Council meeting in June 2024. The Uniting Church itself are developing a Disability Inclusion Plan and All Saints will wait until it becomes available.
- Sunday 15 December is Advent 3 and will be a Children's Service. Letters and Christmas cards will be sent to baptised young members of All Saints.
- Concerns were raised with the management of funerals when funeral companies are not engaged. This matter to be referred to Care Group.
- The 2025 Monthly Retiring Offering schedule was approved.
- ◆ The Chair of the Creative Living Centre is stepping down 31 December. It was agreed that Rev Reuben Edmonds take on the role of Chair until April 2025 AGM. It was agreed that the Church Council endorses Rev Reuben Edmonds being the Chair for 12 months following the AGM.
- Draft signage for the new fixed sign at the front corner of the property was tabled and approved by circular approval after modifications were made to it.
- ◆ Approval was given to Rev Reuben Edmonds that he, along with two members of the congregation, attend the "Godly Play" course scheduled for March 2025.

- The Mission Planning team have met and will continue to do so to formulate the Church's Mission Plan. Input from members of the congregation is required.
- A Blue Christmas service to be held at 5pm Sunday, 8 December.
- ◆ A Carol Service to be held at 7 pm Tuesday, 17 December. Donations will be requested to cover the cost of eight singers who will be involved in the service.
- The 2025 Draft Budget was tabled. It will be finalised in January 2025.
- ◆ Council approved a new Budget Process for the 2026 Budget. The 2026 finalised Budget to be presented to Council on Tuesday, 11 November 2025 for approval. The Church Council approved 2026 Budget will be presented to the congregation at a Congregational meeting scheduled for Sunday, 30 November 2025.

# Can you Help Please?


Marika will be away from the office from 25 December 2024 to 3 January 2025 inclusive.

# Trial for Recycling Soft Plastics



According to Clean Up Australia's most recent Litter Report\*\*, soft plastic pieces such as plastic bags, bread bags, cling film, confectionary wrappers and fresh and frozen produce bags, are the most common item found in litter. In addition to that, the amount of soft plastic collected has increased compared to the year before due to increased use by consumers and a lack of current facilities and programs to collect.

Research into the recycling of soft plastics is being carried out and

you can help by participating in the collection of soft plastics. A community collection/drop off point will be available in the Floreat Forum for the next three weeks and can be found opposite the Floreat Market and Post Office. Please save all your soft plastics and take them to the drop off point.

Your assistance in this important research will be greatly appreciated.
