
This restaurant is in a building which looked as though it could have been a warehouse in a former life. We all enjoyed our meal especially the cake!!

Trial for Recycling Soft Plastics



According to Clean Up Australia's most recent Litter Report** soft plastic pieces such as plastic bags, bread bags, cling film, confectionary wrappers and fresh and frozen produce bags, are the most common item found in litter. In addition to that, the amount of soft plastic collected has increased compared to the year before due to increased use by consumers and a lack of current facilities and programs to collect.

Research into the recycling of soft plastics is being carried out and

you can help by participating in the collection of soft plastics. A community collection/drop off point is available in the Floreat Forum for the next three weeks and can be found opposite the Floreat Market and Post Office. Please save all your soft plastics and take them to the drop off point.
