Uniting Church in Australia Anniversary - 22 June 1977



The Uniting Church in Australia (UCA) was founded on 22 June 1977 when most congregations of the Methodist Church of Australasia, about two-thirds of the Presbyterian

Church of Australia and almost all the churches of the Congregational Union of Australia united under the Basis of Union.

Union did not happen overnight, discussions between the denominations occurred over decades as they wrestled with who God was calling them to be. On the 22nd, members of the three union churches met in different parts of the Sydney CBD. The purpose of these meetings was to dissolve those union Churches and resolve to join the Uniting Church. After those meetings they walked together to the Sydney Town Hall for the inauguration service which included a choir of 400 voices and was broadcast on the ABC.
