### Fruits of the Spirit



After celebrating the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Epiphany, Lent, and Easter we are now heading into the season After Pentecost, sometimes called Ordinary Time.

This is a period of time that varies in length depending on whether Easter is early or late. In this period, the church recalls its faith in the Holy Trinity. It seeks to relate its faith as a people of God to Christ's

mission in the world. It commences with Trinity Sunday and concludes with the feast of Christ the King. This ends the church calendar year, and a new year begins with Advent.

The season After Pentecost is also a time when churches can consider a theme and may choose different readings from the lectionary. Last year we had the season of creation in September. This year we are going to begin with 9 weeks (29th June – 24th August) exploring the fruit of the Spirit. Each week we will focus on one fruit, each week we will include the Galatians reading and each week we will begin with the same call to worship and finish with the same blessing song.


