## *Baptisms at Marble Bar*



On Sunday the 20th of July, Rev David Jackson baptised 10 members of a local family across four generations in the Marble Bar Pool on the Coongan River. David was assisted by Etonia Delana, an elder from the Hedland Fijian Faith Community. This wonderful opportunity to see God at work through the sacrament of baptism is

a result of David's support for the Marble Bar Youth Project in his ministry as the Frontier Services Bush Chaplain for the Pilbara (a patrol about the same size as Victoria!).

The Marble Bar program includes time for yarning, learning to sew, writing comic books, growing veggies, and connecting with the children's culture through language and cooking. The children are also learning leadership skills. It is also wonderful to see the ongoing connections between David's ministry and the Hedland Fijian Faith Community.
