#### Dear White Peacemakers



I am in an ecumenical clergy book club and the latest book we have read is 'dear white peacemakers' by Osheta Moore. She is a writer & pastor based in Saint Paul, Minnesota, USA. She describes her book as a "breakup letter to division, a love letter to God's Beloved Community, and an eviction notice to the violent

powers that have sustained racism for centuries."

Friends, I cannot recommend this book highly enough. It is very accessible, particularly as Osheta weaves in lyrics of spirituals and personal experiences, as she explains why white Christians are called to be peacemakers. It is confronting at times, encouraging at others and always expresses the love of Christ for black and white people alike. While the book is deeply rooted in her experiences in the US, the theology she preaches is just as applicable here in Australia.

Osheta strongly argues for the anti-racism movement but begins with a reminder that white supremacy has dehumanised both the oppressed and the oppressor and we are all Beloved by God. She suggests that shame is the barrier to belovedness and is not a helpful starting place for white peacemakers. Anit-racism is not about internalizing hate for your own skin. However Osheta is also clear that "a profound act of peacemaking is to hear the cries of suffering and move toward relieving that suffering, even if that means we'd have to suffer to."

### Mark your calendars for the 2025 Ageing Well Expo






