Chevron City To Surf For Activ



This weekend the City to Surf kicks off again and thousands of people walk and run from the city to the beach.

Established in 1975, the Chevron City to Surf for Activ serves as Activ's premier fundraising event, with a purpose that extends far

beyond a community fun run. Funds raised from the event go directly to supporting the thousands of people living with disability in Western Australia.

Activ has more than 5,000 staff who serve and advocate for more than 65,000 people. They have hubs around the state specialising in Accommodation, Community, Training, Behaviour Support, Employment, NDIS Planning and more. They believe that greater accessibility and inclusion for people living with disability benefits all of society, and everyone has a role in expanding opportunities. Activ is working towards a world where people living with disability have the same opportunities as everyone else. To live a life of their choice, in their community. Their services are designed to help their customers, their families, and carers to Live, Learn, and Work with confidence.

As a not-for-profit, Activ rely heavily on the funds raised at the City to Surf event each year. These funds allow them to research,

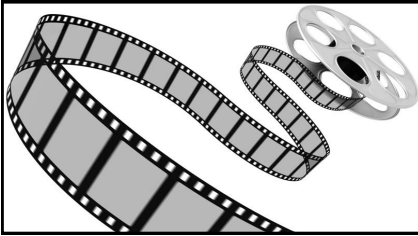

Friendship Group News

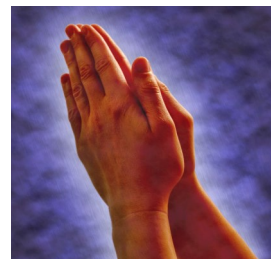
