Important Notice on behalf of the Synod Standing Committee

At a special meeting held last Thursday, the Synod Standing Committee gave priority attention to the imminent change in the position of General Secretary.

With the conclusion of Rev Dr Andrew Williams in the role on 31 October, regulations give the Synod Standing Committee responsibility to appoint a person to the vacancy to fulfil constitutional requirements.

The Synod Standing Committee determined to appoint David Beards as General Secretary for the period 1 to 30 November 2025. David will serve in this role as a temporary appointment.

The Synod Standing Committee is in final stages of a proposal regarding the longer term appointment to the position of General Secretary after 1 December 2025, and will consider the proposal at the Standing Committee's ordinary meeting on 20 October 2025.
