Installation of David Jackson



It was wonderful to attend the installation of Rev David Jackson as the next Moderator of the Synod of WA on Saturday the 25th of October. The service was a joy filled testament to the ministry of David and our church. This particularly shone through with the involvement of the Fijian community. David has

worked closely with the Hedland Fijian Faith Community and his mentoring and guidance enabled the group to become part of our Uniting Church family, which included renovating and reopening a Uniting Church in the Pilbara. Reopening a church is rare so this was a wonderful celebration. During the installation we heard from the Fijian choir and after the service there was ceremony and the drinking of kava. I have no doubt David will provide excellent pastoral leadership of our church as we continue to find ways to spread the good news of Jesus Christ across our state.

This service also marked the conclusion of Rev Dr Ian Tozer's term as Moderator. It has been a challenging term, and it has taken a toll on Ian.
