### Through Him, All Things

As I created this piece, I thought about a prism. I remember the first time I used this seemingly magical, transparent stone. I held it to the light, which I could not see, and to my surprise the light was broken down into the vibrant colours of a rainbow. It was natural for me to think the stone was creating something that

wasn't there, but this medium revealed the complex truth that light is in fact made up of all the colours in existence.

In my image, Jesus is a prism. The light that is life that comes from the Creator shines through Jesus, and it is through him that we can see the fullness and beauty of who God is. It is through him that all of Creation came into being. I decided to paint the colours of the rainbow in the order I learned as a child: ROYGBIV. It was when picking paints that I realized there are seven colours in a simplified rainbow, and there are also seven days of Creation. In this block carving, each of the days of Creation is referenced through simplified patterning in each of the colours of the rainbow.
